CHARACTERISTICS

Height: 4-5'

Width: 5-6'

Identification: This is an evergreen shrub, but it tends to be semi-evergreen to deciduous near the northern edge of its growing range. Small leaves and grown in a dense round form.

GROWING CONDITIONS

Native Habitat: Eastern North America (Zone: 6 to 9)

Water: Medium to wet

Sun Light: Full sun to part shade

Easily grown near stream banks, and low moist open woods. It does like afternoon shade in hot climates and may grow suckers to form a thicket.

BENEFITS

This cultivar does well as a foundation planting. Fragrant flowers for informal hedges, screens, barriers, foundations, and borders.
