WHEREAS: the investment made by Fayetteville in Goodwill Industries has paid off in useful work and jobs for our citizens, and


WHEREAS: Goodwill Industries of Arkansas is celebrating Goodwill Industries Week,

"GOODWILL INDUSTRIES WEEK"


in Fayetteville, Arkansas and urge all citizens to give support to Goodwill Industries in recognition of its ability to maximize an individual's contribution to self, family and community.
