Proclamation




- WHEREAS:** the City of Fayetteville's designation as the 3rd best place to live in the country is due in large part to the quality of life we enjoy because of our investment in infrastructure and healthy lifestyles, and
- WHEREAS:** during Bike Month every year, we celebrate that bicycling is an important component of Fayetteville's present and future transportation system for residents and visitors, and
- WHEREAS:** a trail usage study recently commissioned by the Walton Family Foundation shows that usage in Northwest Arkansas is on par with cyclists in San Francisco and pedestrians in San Diego County. That study showed that three sections of the Scull Creek Trail in Fayetteville are seeing more than 150,000 cyclists a year, and
- WHEREAS:** this city provides a safe pedestrian and bicycle interstate for healthy exercise and tourism for our region, and
- WHEREAS:** the second annual Square to Square ride from Fayetteville to Bentonville will provide 32 miles of scenic beauty and commerce for patrons to enjoy, and
- WHEREAS:** we wish to celebrate the Razorback Greenway as the bridge between our two anchor cities of the Northwest Arkansas Region, and
- WHEREAS:** we gather today to celebrate this legacy we leave for generations to come,

"RAZORBACK GREENWAY APPRECIATION DAY"


